Cliff Johnson, Cold Spring Area Historical Society gave an update and said they were hosting an event on April 2, 2025, about the involvement of Minnesota Sailors on the U.S.S. Ward at Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941. He will continue to give periodic updates as the club holds events in the future.

Kevin Kruger, WSB and Jodi Teich, Stearns County Engineer gave an update on the 246<sup>th</sup> bridge replacement. The project is ready to advertise for bids. With Township approval, Stearns County would draft the contract, advertise for bids, and make payments and reimbursements.
